### 1. Grounds Committee

- TF-R suggested an Easter sponsored walk instead of fill a tube. Kids will still get the Easter bunny choc treat and the sponsored walk is a separate fundraiser.
- KL suggested a JustGiving page to make it easier although kids do like a sheet to show how much they've raised. Maybe an actual sponsorship sheet plus a JG option as well so the sheets can go back into school with any cash.
