JJ – noise about lack of progress on playground equipment, lack of communication. GA – Was in newsletters. Will also be covered in parent forum letter, first one will be about playground updates. Will go ahead during term time once can do it (have enough space) – should take 2 weeks once have access. Very frustrating.

Walton Charity good relationship.

JJ – roof? Could you fit a solar panel. GA – Y6 have come to with the same idea. Figures from JJ. 63KW panel system for entire roof would cost roughly £80k. 60000kwh per year – assumption is use 50%, export 50%. Home cost 35p per kWH – if use 30000 in a year, £10K off bill, if export at 6-9p kwh £1600-2700 from electricity board. Pay back over 10 years.

CIL fund?? Not for profit company that sets up co-operatives, Burhill Solar PV, buy shares

Action Point - Can JJ see if can get more official figures and run with it to CIL? GA happy to support
